LIST OF ELIGIBLE COURSES

As per College rules, a certificate eligible course must either have at least 15% of its content dedicated to the certificate theme or allow students to complete one or several projects on the certificate theme totaling at least 25% of the course grade.

Please note that the column “teacher required” indicates that the course must be taken with that teacher. If no teacher is indicated as required, the course can be taken with any teacher offering it. **Not all courses are offered each semester.**

Social Science students: your ISS and RM courses will each be eligible for the SSC if you write (in each case) your major project on a sports theme. Consult with your teacher.

ALC students: your IS course will be eligible for the SSC if you write your major project on a sports theme. Consult with your teacher.
