
Round 1 application:

- STEP 3: Teacher must write letter of reference and email it to the Honours program coordinator
- Honours Science: Science or Math teacher*
- Honours Social Science: Any teacher*

- Admissions evaluates all SRAM applications
- Honours coordinators reviews applications
 - Letter of intent
 - Letter of reference
 - Academic profile
- Honours students are selected by the Honours coordinators
 - Probably 3rd or 4th week of March – depends on number of applications
 - Students will receive an email to say either
 - Selected
 - Waitlist
 - No room
- Student must confirm their spot in Honours

Police Technology & Paramedic Care

Police Technology

- Testing in December, February and March
Registration on website is now open
- Driver's License
Probationary License by March 1st
If not: Pathways to Police Technology

Paramedic Care

- Testing in March (AFTER APPLICATION)
By invitation only
- Pathways to Paramedic Care is an option for students not admitted to Paramedic Care. They must apply to Pathways to a Career.

Professional Theatre: Acting


- Submit application through SRAM by March 1 deadline.
- Candidates will be invited (**by invitation only**) to an audition (acting) after the application deadline.
- Candidates selected will be given a precise date and time to participate in the audition process.



Visual Arts

- Submit an application to SRAM by the March 1 deadline;
- Submit as one PDF:
 - One artwork image (visual component)
 - A letter of introduction (written component) explaining the creative process the student went through to produce their work of art
- Email PDF to visual.arts@johnabbott.qc.ca by the March 1 deadline.
 - The subject line of the email must be: VA_Submission_YOUR NAME_2024

ACCESS CENTRE MANDATE

Our mandate is to collaborate with teachers, staff, and outside agencies in order to offer accommodations to students who have limitations and/or incapacities resulting from a specific diagnosis and/or medical condition.

Our goal is to empower students who require accommodations to become autonomous and self-regulated learners for their future endeavors by striving to give them an equal opportunity to learn and succeed.

WHO WE SUPPORT

Students who present appropriate documentation* addressing disabilities such as:

- Mental Health Disorders
- Hearing and Visual Impairments
- Physical Disabilities
- Specific Learning Disabilities
- Neurological Disorders
- Any other medical conditions resulting in limitations and/or incapacities, including temporary conditions such as concussions.

* Type of appropriate documentation includes: full medical, psychiatric, and or psycho-educational assessment.

Q: What documentation must students provide if they are seeking accommodations at the CEGEP level? To clarify, is an IEP robust enough?

A: An IEP is not enough to get accommodations.


