- Students will be required to pass a Ministerial Exam of Language of Instruction and a Program Comprehensive Assessment.
- All program courses are sequential and require the preceding level course as a pre-requisite.

- Students in the Multidisciplinary Option may take any courses as electives taking into account pre-requisites.
- Students in the multidisciplinary option must ensure that they have met the requirements for the integrating seminar they wish to take.
- Students in the multidisciplinary option who wish to do a Languages IA, do not need to have a level 3 French course.
- Students must take Universe of the Arts 1 (UNA), 2 (UNB) and 3 (UNC) and have completed 9 program-specific courses BEFORE taking Integrating Activity*.
- Students must take Cultural courses (CCA), 2 (CCB) and 3 (CFC) and have completed 9 program-specific courses BEFORE taking Integrating Activity*.
- Universe of the Arts courses must be taken in order. Culture Courses must be taken in order
